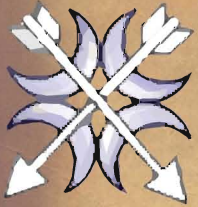


- Route approaching from West

Directions to Santiago Park Archery Range:

From whichever direction you are coming from, find your way to the 22 freeway, either Westbound from the 55 Freeway or Eastbound from I-5 or the 57 Freeway, then follow directions below.

Westbound on the 22 from the 55 Freeway:

- Take the Main Street Exit.
- At the bottom of the ramp, **turn right** onto La Veta Ave.
- Go through the light at Batavia to the next light at Parker, and **turn right**.
- Cross under the freeway, and through the light at Town and Country Rd. (Parker changes name to Memory Lane At this point)
- Approximately 500' past Town and Country Rd., where the street begins to curve to the right, **turn left** at driveway with a sign next to for the Santiago Park Nature Reserve. There is smaller sign next to it for the archery range.
- Proceed down this road past the nature center and playground, until you come to the railroad bridge over the road. The range is just past the bridge. Park wherever you can find space.

Eastbound on the 22 from I-5 or the 57 Freeway:

- Take the Main Street Exit.
- At the bottom of the ramp, **turn left** onto Town and Country Rd.
- Go to the end of the street, and **turn right onto Parker**. (Parker changes name to Memory Lane At this point)
- Approximately 500' past Town and Country Rd., where the street begins to curve to the right, **turn left** at driveway with a sign next to for the Santiago Park Nature Reserve. There is smaller sign next to it for the archery range.
- Proceed down this road past the nature center and playground, until you come to the railroad bridge over the road. The range is just past the bridge. Park wherever you can find space.
